NOTE 1.—Italicized dates indicate the first day of the regular term of court.

NOTE 2.—Court will open at 9:30 a. m. in Garnett and Ottawa.

NOTE 3.—In Barber, Harper, Kingman and Pratt counties, court convenes at 10:00 a. m. on all motion days. Court convenes at 9:30 a. m. for jury trials. Term and motion day in Barber county is July 9th.

NOTE 4.—In Barton, Rice and Stafford counties, court convenes at 10:00 a. m., except when jury appears, when court will convene at 9:00 a. m. NOTE 5.—In Bourbon county July 11th is motion day. In Linn county July 9th is motion day. In Miami county July 10th is motion day. All motion days court convenes at 10:00 a. m. and on days fixed for jury trials court convenes at 9:00 a. m.

NOTE 6.—In Clark, Comanche, Ford and Gray counties, court convenes at 10:00 a. m. In Kiowa and Meade counties court convenes at 2:00 p. m. Terms: February 19 and September 24 in Clark county.

Terms: May 21 and December 3 in Comanche county.

Terms: January 15, April 16 and September 10 in Ford county.

Terms: April 2 and November 12 in Gray county.

Terms: May 7 and October 8 in Kiowa county.

Terms: March 19 and October 22 in Meade county. (Terms open at 10:00 a. m.)

NOTE 7.—In Marshall county opening day of term delayed one day a/c New Year holiday and Labor Day. In addition to the regular motion days in Riley county, time permitting, special motion days will be held on the 3rd Friday of the month. Additional motion days are scheduled in Clay, Marshall and Riley counties as the need arises.

NOTE 8.—In Ellis, Gove, Logan, Russell and Trego counties, all dates 9:00 a. m. Wallace county court will convene at 1:00 p. m. NOTE 9.—In Finney, Greeley, Hamilton, Kearny, Lane, Scott and Wichita counties, motion days, 10:00 a. m. and 2:00 p. m. Jury sessions 9:30 a. m. (unless otherwise ordered). First day of each regular term, 10:00 a. m.

NOTE 10.—In Crawford county, July 11th is motion day in Pittsburg. July 6th is motion day in Girard.

NOTE 11.—In Douglas county, court will open at 9:30 a. m. It is also provided that on the days on which a term of court opens, the civil docket will be called beginning at 9:30 a. m. and the criminal docket will be called at 2:00 p. m. Also, July 6th and August 3rd are motion days.

NOTE 12.—In Dickinson county, no jury at May term. No jury in Morris and Geary counties at June term, except on special order. All sessions, 10:00 a. m.

NOTE 13.—In Grant, Haskell, Morton, Seward, Stanton and Stevens counties, first day of each regular term court will convene at 10:00 a. m. Motion days—forenoon sessions, 10:00 a. m., afternoon sessions, 2:00 p. m. Jury sessions 10:00 a. m. (unless otherwise ordered).

NOTE 14.—In Harvey and McPherson counties, all cases commence at 9:30 a. m.

NOTE 15.—In Jackson, Jefferson and Pottawatomie counties, court convenes at 9:00 a. m. on the opening day of the term. On motion days, court will convene at 10:00 a. m. Time permitting, a special motion day will be held in each county two weeks after the regular motion days.

NOTE 16.—In Osage and Wabausee counties, court convenes at 10:00 a. m.

NOTE 17.—In Shawnee county, the schedule continues through July and August as follows:

Division No. 1.—Judge Beryl R. Johnson, July 20 and August 17.

Division No. 2.—Judge Marion Beatty, July 27 and August 24.

Division No. 3.—Judge Dean McElhenry, July 6 and August 3 and 31.

Division No. 4.—Judge David Prager, July 13 and August 10.

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
