## Notes on Use

The judge is required to inform a juvenile, or parent or legal guardian, of the availability of testing for HIV or hepatitis B infection and counseling if the juvenile is charged with an offense involving a sexual act or any offense if the nature of the charge appears to have involved the transmission of body fluids from one person to another. This notice should be given at the time of the first appearance. The judge shall also inform each alleged victim of the offense. If the alleged victim is a minor, the parent shall be notified. The tests contemplated by the statute are HIV and hepatitis B. K.S.A. 38-2317.
